There are no Marshall's dogs on site as yet. It is envisaged to be towards end of year before first arrivals. All practices/animal husbandry procedures and rehoming policies appear unchanged and steady state. At time of visit colony size was all RCC and as follows: 29 male and 310 female breeders. 26 reserve females, no reserve males.

Stock animals 650 males, 530 females.

Currently plan is to decrease colony by approx one third by end of year. Number of matings planned in have been decreased in consequence.

The 26 breeders that are currently planned to join colony will still do so but thereafter no more breeders from RCC line.

All animals appeared bright, alert and in good order.

Minor issues noted at visit included 1 young pup(unweaned) slight lameness,1 adult dog with weight bearing lameness. Since visit a report has been received that these issues have resolved with no treatment(pup) and with medication(adult).

There was also a juvenile approx 6 months old ,with one testicle,notably underweight compared to both its conspecific litter mates and in regard to its own growth curve. Weight static to weight loss over a number of weighings such that animal grown in bone structure but not in weight meaning that body condition poor. This animal, as cryptorchid ,will not be sold for study and as ill thrift unlikely to be rehomed. Course of action separate with one companion ,increase feed over weekend and then reassess with vet early next week. Animal bright and alert so reasonable course of action.

NB report received that the animal did not gain weight over weekend,in fact lost t more and humanely
killed beginning of week on vet advice. No abnormal pathology findings to explain weight loss. Undescended
testicle next to kidney.
