Facilities	Low level concerns	<p>I inspected in Buildings REDACTED and REDACTED. Accommodation in Buildings REDACTED and REDACTED was in good condition. Building REDACTED, the most recent refurbishment, was empty temporarily as there were issues with the heating.</p> <p>Buildings REDACTED and REDACTED are showing signs of wear and tear, most notably in the floor surface of the corridor sections. There are implications for ease of cleaning and the (small) potential for injury. There are plans to refurbish some of these areas and to take others out of commission. These plans have been delayed by Covid.</p> <p>I discussed the provision of environmental enrichment in Building REDACTED with REDACTED. These pens were barren except for suspended barrels. I was told that dogs had only recently been moved there from Building REDACTED. REDACTED agreed to ensure that platforms and suspended toys would be moved across.
